## WHO

## WHAT

The volunteers will be:

- Visiting groups to promote Healthwatch Nottingham & Nottinghamshire, deliver talks and to encourage their members to complete our current Hot Topic questionnaire.
- Carrying out interviews or surveys with the public for a particular project or piece of work.
- Attending health and social care related public events to promote Healthwatch Nottingham & Nottinghamshire and build contacts.
- Promoting our current Hot Topic or survey through their own networks and contacts, including through social media.

## Good To Know
