What

This role will provide strategic support to the CEO in the oversight and quality control of Healthwatch Nottingham & Nottinghamshire projects. The volunteer will bring their research and projects expertise to provide feedback on research methodologies, project initiation documents, surveys, interview questions, ethics and draft reports, becoming a key member of the Evidence and Insight Sub Group which meets four times a year.

Application process: there will be an initial chat with the programme and insights manager and CEO, you will need to complete an application form, which will then be followed by an interview and the uptake of references for suitable candidates.
